The epidural gives you one option: laying in bed. Without the epidural, you are able to walk, bounce, bathe or do whatever helps you make it through the contractions. Simply being in the upright position (not laying on a bed) is helpful because of gravity. Also, during natural childbirth, your body will produce oxytocin (source).

Birth Without An Epidural: Can You Do It?

Almost 70 percent of women report they had an epidural or other spinal anesthesia during labor, and just 16% say they received no pain medication at all. We can't predict which category you'll fall into because there's not much research on how many women end up having an epidural even though they intended not to have one.

Another option for pain relief during labor is nitrous oxide. In higher doses, it acts as an anesthetic and anti-anxiety so it's very helpful during childbirth. Some benefits of using nitrous oxide are that it doesn't affect the baby in any way, it doesn't affect the release of oxytocin and it doesn't hinder breastfeeding.

A combined spinal-epidural block, which takes effect quicker than does an epidural and has lower doses of anesthetic medications, might leave you with more muscle strength.

Neuraxial labor analgesia is known to increase the rate of instrumental delivery and prolong the second stage of labor; however, there is no standard method to evaluate the progress of labor under analgesia. Lumbar epidural analgesia: Epidural analgesia is appropriate at virtually any time of labor when the parturient experiences painful contractions, provided there are no contraindications. In the past, epidural analgesia was withheld until parturient was in the active phase of labor (cervix 4 to 6 cms dilated).

Epidural anesthesia or analgesia provides relief or reduction of labor pain without affecting the mother's mental state. It enables an exhausted mother to relax or sleep during labor and calms the woman who is anxious and tense because of pain.

The most common methods of analgesia during labor in high-income settings are regional analgesic methods [1]. These include both epidural analgesia, primarily initiated in the first stage of labor; and pudendal analgesia, provided during the second stage of labor [2]. Epidural analgesia is by far the most common method.

Seventy-nine (37.26%) women received epidural analgesia, 87 (41.04%) intravenous drugs, and 46 (21.7%) women gave birth without anesthesia.

Epidural Analgesia and Back Pain after Labor

Epidural analgesia in the latent phase of labor at cervical dilation of 1.0 cm or more does not prolong the progression of labor and does not increase the rate of Cesarean in nulliparous women compared with the delayed analgesia at the cervical dilation of 4.0 cm or more.

Labor analgesia has been widely accepted in clinical practice, and an epidural block remains the most effective method of providing pain relief during labor.1-3Previous meta-analyses, however, have indicated that epidural analgesia may slightly prolong the second stage of labor and increase the instrumental birth rate compared with nonepidural analgesia.4,5Effects on the second stage of labor may be mediated by the concentration of local anesthetics.

Effects of Epidural Labor Analgesia With Low ...

Epidural analgesia (EA) is an effective method of pain management in labour. It is considered the reference standard for pain relief and is preferable to other methods of pain relief such as the use of systemic opioids, nitrous oxide and not pharmacological methods [1-5].
