Where it applies, Section 92.056 of the Texas Property Code is generally the tenant's strongest weapon in the fight to secure repairs. This is because the Property Code gives the tenant the strongest remedies if the landlord breaches its obligations: the tenant can terminate the lease, or get a court order forcing the landlord to fix things.

Under Texas law, landlords must make certain disclosures to tenants (usually in the lease or rental agreement), such as tenant rights when a landlord fails to make repairs. In 1979, Texas legislation effectively extinguished the implied warranty by enacting Subchapter B of Section 92 of the Texas Property Code. As stated in that subchapter, the law replaced existing common law (case law) and other statutory law, warranties and duties of residential landlords for maintenance and repair of rental units.
