## **Designating Ramsar Sites | Ramsar**

The Ramsar Convention defines wetlands as "areas of marsh, fen, peatland or water, whether natural or artificial, permanent or temporary, with water that is static or flowing, fresh, brackish or salt, including areas of marine water the depth of which at low tide does not exceed six meters." ## **How to Apply to RAMSAR**

Criteria for identifying Wetlands of International Importance. Under the Ramsar Criteria, wetlands should be selected for the Ramsar List on account of their international significance in terms of the biodiversity and uniqueness of their ecology, botany, zoology, limnology or hydrology. In addition, the Criteria indicates that in the first instance, wetlands of international importance to waterbirds at any season should be included on the Ramsar List.

## **Criteria for identifying Wetlands of International ...**

A wetland can be considered internationally important if any of the following nine criteria apply: Criterion 1: "it contains a representative, rare, or unique example of a natural or near-natural wetland type found... Criterion 2: "it supports vulnerable, endangered, or critically endangered species ...
